## Medical Care Programs

### Medicaid (Medical Assistance)

- Health Insurance for low-income families, children, the elderly and people with disabilities
- Long term care for older individuals
- Supplemental coverage for low-income Medicare beneficiaries

### Maryland Children's Health Program (MCHP)

- Gives full benefits for children up to age 19 and pregnant women of any age.

### MCHP Premium

- Low cost health plan for uninsured children up to age 19.

Medical assistance for families depending on income eligibility, parents and /or family members caring for children on MCHP may be able to get Medical Assistance.

## Eligibility Requirements

In order to apply for Medicaid, Maryland Children's Health Program (MCHP) or Medical Assistance for families, you will need:

- Proof of citizenship or permanent US residency (US birth certificate, US citizen ID)

**AND**

- Proof of identity (school ID with photo, drivers license, hospital or daycare record that shows date and place of birth)
