What is MAPC

The Medicaid Personal Care Program provides assistance with activities of daily living to Medicaid recipients who have a chronic illness, medical condition or disability.



Services are provided by self-employed or agency employed providers, who are approved and monitored by a nurse case monitor from the Harford County Health Department. Services are provided in the eligible individual's home or community residence.

Services

Services provided in the program include assistance with these activities of daily living:

- Bathing
- Toileting
- Transferring
- Mobility
- Eating
- Nutritional planning and meal preparation
- Dressing

Services for individuals who need help with activities of daily living may also receive help with:

- Household services related to medical needs
- Food shopping
- Escort services to medical appointments
- Personal hygiene and grooming

How to Apply

To apply for the program, contact the Harford County Health Department on 410-612-1779.

Qualified applicants must meet both the Medicaid Program's financial and medical requirements.

Services will continue as long as the individual remains eligible for Medical Assistance, is in need of services and a provider is available.
