Job title	NURSE PRACTITIONER/MIDWIFE I/II Consultant
Position Summary	<p>This position is for a nurse practitioner or midwife with training and experience in providing clinical family planning and contraceptive services for both females and males, basic women’s health services, and sexually transmitted disease diagnosis and treatment services to provide clinical care in a local health department setting. The ideal candidate would have local public health experience in the areas of primary and preventive care and be able to perform: direct medical care services, clinical consultation, program development and representation.</p>
Required Qualifications	<p>Minimum Education: Determined by the Maryland State Board of Examiners of Nurses under the certification requirements for Nurse Practitioner or Nurse Midwife.</p> <p>Minimum Experience: One year of experience as a Nurse Practitioner or as a Nurse Midwife.</p> <p>Licenses, Registrations and Certifications:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Candidates must possess a current certificate as a Nurse Practitioner (preferably Family or Women’s Health) or as a Nurse Midwife from the Maryland State Board of Nursing, 4140 Patterson Avenue, Baltimore, Maryland 21215.• Candidates must possess a Maryland State Division of Drug Control registration certificate.• Candidates must possess a Basic CPR (Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation) certificate.• Consultant contract candidates must possess a malpractice insurance coverage certificate. <p>Other Requirements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Candidates must provide malpractice claims explanations for the past 10 years.• Candidates must provide a work history (e.g., a curriculum vitae).• Candidates must provide a criminal/civil history.• Candidates must provide three references.• Candidates must have a Nurse Practitioner Attestation or Nurse Midwife Collaborative Plan approved by the Maryland Board of Nursing.• Candidates must be credentialed by commercial health insurance
