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Cancer Prevention Services

WHO WE ARE

The Harford Count Health Department 's Cancer Prevention Services includes a Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening and Navigation Programs.

WHAT WE DO

We provide breast and cervical cancer screenings services as well as a navigation program for women who qualify. For those women who qualify for the program and are found to have breast and/or cervical cancer, the Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening Program will assist them in applying for the Breast and Cervical Cancer Diagnosis and Treatment Program .

PURPOSE

The objective of these services is to reduce disparities related to accessing preventive breast and cervical cancer screening services for all eligible individuals, insured, underinsured and not insured.

BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER

Services Provided:

- No cost annual clinical breast examination
- No cost annual mammograms
- No cost Pap smears (every three-five years on women with an intact cervix)
- Our targeted population: women ages 40-64 and women over 65, if they do not have Medicare Part-B.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a Maryland resident
- Be age 40-64 (can be 65+ if without Medicare part B)
- Be underinsured or uninsured
- Meet the programs income guidelines



PATIENT NAVIGATION SERVICES

This program provides services to address barriers that individuals face in accessing and completing their breast and cervical cancer screenings, diagnostic services and the initiation of treatment, if cancer is diagnosed.

Services Provided:

- Assistance in accessing and scheduling breast and cervical cancer screening services in a timely manner.
- Assistance in problem solving barriers to care: e.g. transportation, translation services, scheduling appointments, education, and emotional support.
- Assistance in paying any copays, coinsurance fees and deductibles. Up to a certain amount.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a Maryland Resident
- Be age 40 and older.
- Be with or without Health Insurance
- Meet the program income guidelines
