Job title	Teen Diversion Program Counselor
Position Summary	<p>This position is for a Masters prepared counselor to provide direct mental health treatment to Teen Diversion clients and their families. The counselor would lead the therapeutic milieu, providing psycho-educational and socialization group activities to the teens attending the program as well as overseeing the behavior management aspects. Additionally, the counselor would provide individual and family therapy to a small case load of 2-4 clients and would co-lead group therapy daily.</p> <p>The ideal candidate would have both behavioral health experience with adolescents and families as well as therapeutic psychiatric rehabilitation experience utilizing multi-modal and experiential methodologies.</p>
