Who We Are

Hospital Outreach is a nursing service of the Harford County Health Department, funded as part of Long Term Care Reform. The program accepts individuals, over the age of 18, who are at risk for long-term placement.



Services

How Can HOP Help You?

The HOP Nurse:

- Assists in locating community resources and completes referrals.
- Assists the patient with identifying barriers in the community.
- Conducts follow-up visits to the home.
- Coordinates with other community agencies and post hospital case managers for the patient returning to the community.
- Assists with patient adherence to the discharge plan and medication management.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Hospital Outreach Program, you must meet these requirements:

- Over 18
- Hospitalized
- Living on a limited income and has limited assets
- At risk of going to a nursing home
