## Patient Screening 3/3/2020

**Ask:** In the last 14 days before symptoms began, have you traveled from mainland China, S. Korea, Italy, Iran or Japan or had close contact with a laboratory confirmed COVID-19 patient or a person who is under investigation for COVID-19 while that person was sick?

Does the patient have fever and lower respiratory symptoms requiring hospitalization with no source of exposure identified, without alternative explanatory diagnosis e.g., influenza?



## **Determine if the patient has the following symptoms:**

- (1) Fever of ≥100.4°F or feel feverish and/or
- (2) Symptoms of lower respiratory illness (e.g., cough, difficulty breathing)







HAVE PATIENT WEAR SURGICAL MASK-Isolate the patient – No physical contact

## NURSE TO DO THE FOLLOWING:

- (1) Isolate patient in a single room with door closed, preferably with private bathroom IF NOT ALREADY DONE.
- (2) Nurse to don PPE observing standard, contact, and airborne precautions. Include :**N-95 fit tested mask**, **eye protection**, **gown and gloves**.
- (3) Do an assessment to include: patient's name, DOB, address, travel history including dates of travel, onset date of symptoms and any contact with other sick persons.
- (4) If patient severely ill, call 911 for transport to hospital Emergency Dept, tell 911 this is a possible Coronavirus case. If patient not severely ill, await further recommendations from the Harford County Health Department.
- (5) CD Nurse/Deputy Health Officer will direct all further actions, as appropriate.
