WHO WE ARE

The Harford County Health Department has a Lead & Asthma program that helps parents create a healthy home environment for themselves and their children.

Healthy Homes for Healthy Kids is a Maryland Department of Health Program between Medicaid, the Environmental Health Bureau, Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD), and the Harford County Health Department.

SERVICES

What can you expect from your Community Health Nurse and Community Health Worker?

- A home visiting program with a Nurse and /or Community Health Worker to educate about maintaining a Healthy Home – free of irritants and allergy causing agents.
- They will provide information, educational materials, and tools to maintain a Healthy Home based on the Principles of a Healthy Home: Dry, Well – Ventilated, Safe, Contaminant Free, and Clean.
- They will work closely with you and your child’s doctor to reduce symptoms and improve your child’s health.
- Help parents reduce the environmental threats that can be harmful to their children.



QUALIFICATIONS

Your child may be eligible for the Harford County Health Department Lead and Asthma Program if they:

- Are a Harford County Resident under the age of 19
- Enrolled in/eligible for Medicaid
- Have a Blood Lead level of 5 mcg/dL and above
- Have a diagnosis of Moderate to Severe Asthma



Your Community Health Nurse and/or Community Health Worker will provide information and instruction on green cleaning your home. Some green cleaning supplies will be provided.
