PrEp

PrEp stands for pre-exposure prophylaxis. PrEp should be considered for people who are currently HIV-negative but may be at high risk for getting HIV infection. PrEp involves taking a pill every day that can help to protect you from getting HIV.

Emergency Contraception (EC)

Emergency contraception is a safe and effective method of birth control that prevents pregnancy after unprotected intercourse.

EC is most effective when taken within 5 days of unprotected intercourse. EC is NOT an abortion pill. It will not end a pregnancy that is already established.
